Reduced fragmentation of ASNW

Reduced run-off and peak flows into water course

ALDER PLANTED IN LOWER WET AREA

Open semi-natural habitats to remain unplanted

HORIZONTAL EAST/WEST RIDE

4m Perimeter access track to provide internal open space

Linking existing ASNW to east and west. Buffering against climatic impacts

Internal Glade over historic site

Native broadleaf planting oak mosaic @ 1600 stems/Ha with birch, rowan and woody shrubs providing graded
