1. **Apologies for absence** – To received apologies for absence.
2. **Declarations of interest** – In accordance with the Code of Conduct, members are required to declare any personal or disclosable pecuniary interests, including the nature and extent of such interest they may have, in items to be considered at this meeting. Members are also reminded that any change to their Declaration of Interests must be notified to the Monitoring Officer at West Devon Borough Council within 28 days of the change. If a member becomes aware, during the course of the Meeting, of an interest that has not been disclosed they must do so immediately.
3. **Public Participation** – An opportunity for members of the public to make representations, answer and give evidence in respect of any item of business on the agenda. The period of time designated for public participation shall not exceed 2 minutes per person except by the direction of the chair (Standing Orders 3f and 3g). The public are to be reminded of the Protocol for Public Participation in Town Council Meetings must be adhered to and members of the public are not allowed to raise issues when the Council is in Committee (please note that decisions cannot be made on items not detailed on the agenda).
